Horse owners must be aware that these symptoms might also be associated with other common equine health and disease conditions.

Respiratory Allergies in Horses

Heaves is the term most Veterinaries use for respiratory allergies in horses. The symptoms can include coughing, exercise intolerance and nasal discharge. It is extremely similar to asthma in humans. In some horses, owners will notice wheezing associated with respiratory allergies.
